Information for Parents and Carers

Bradford Child Development Centre (CDC)

We provide assessment and treatment facilities for children with developmental difficulties. Those difficulties may be physical, intellectual and/or in communication

Who are we?

We are a team of doctors, therapists, health visitors, psychologists, nursery nurses and social workers. We work together to help the child and advise parents and carers.

Who will see my child?

It depends on the individual. Each child will see a children's doctor (Developmental Paediatrician) and other members of the team, according to need. You may have met some members of the team already.

Are the appointments all on the same day?

They are usually spread out. Individual appointments are given to see different team members, but sometimes two or more staff may work with your child.

Will I be involved?

Yes, we value working closely with parents and carers.

Is there anything I need to do before the first appointment?

We expect the main carer(s) to attend with the child. It might be helpful to think about the main questions that you want to ask us. Some parents/carers find it useful to write them down. It will be helpful to bring the Child Health records with you (the red book).

What if I cannot attend the first appointment?

Please let us know as soon as possible. The appointment can be given to someone else and we can re-arrange your appointment.

What if we need an interpreter?

Please let us know in advance and we will try to arrange an interpreter.

Have you any other facilities?

We can offer advice about:

- Supportive services and groups
- Allowances
- Equipment
- Adaptations to the home

There is a toy library, open to any child with special needs. The librarians can advise on suitable toys to borrow for use at home. Also, the Laura Jackson Library has books and videos which may be borrowed by children and parents. [Library Tel:](#) 01274 365463 (mornings).
