The only time we can allow 1 adult visitor is for:

- People who are receiving end of life care
- When a child is in hospital
- When attending as a birthing partner.

If you are worried about a loved one and you are not able to visit them in hospital you can call our Relatives Line.

The line is run by qualified clinical staff. They can give you daily updates on how your loved ones are getting on.



To speak to the team you can call 01274 272747 Monday to Sunday anytime between 8am to 10pm.


