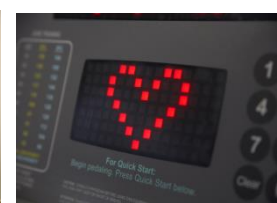

Background

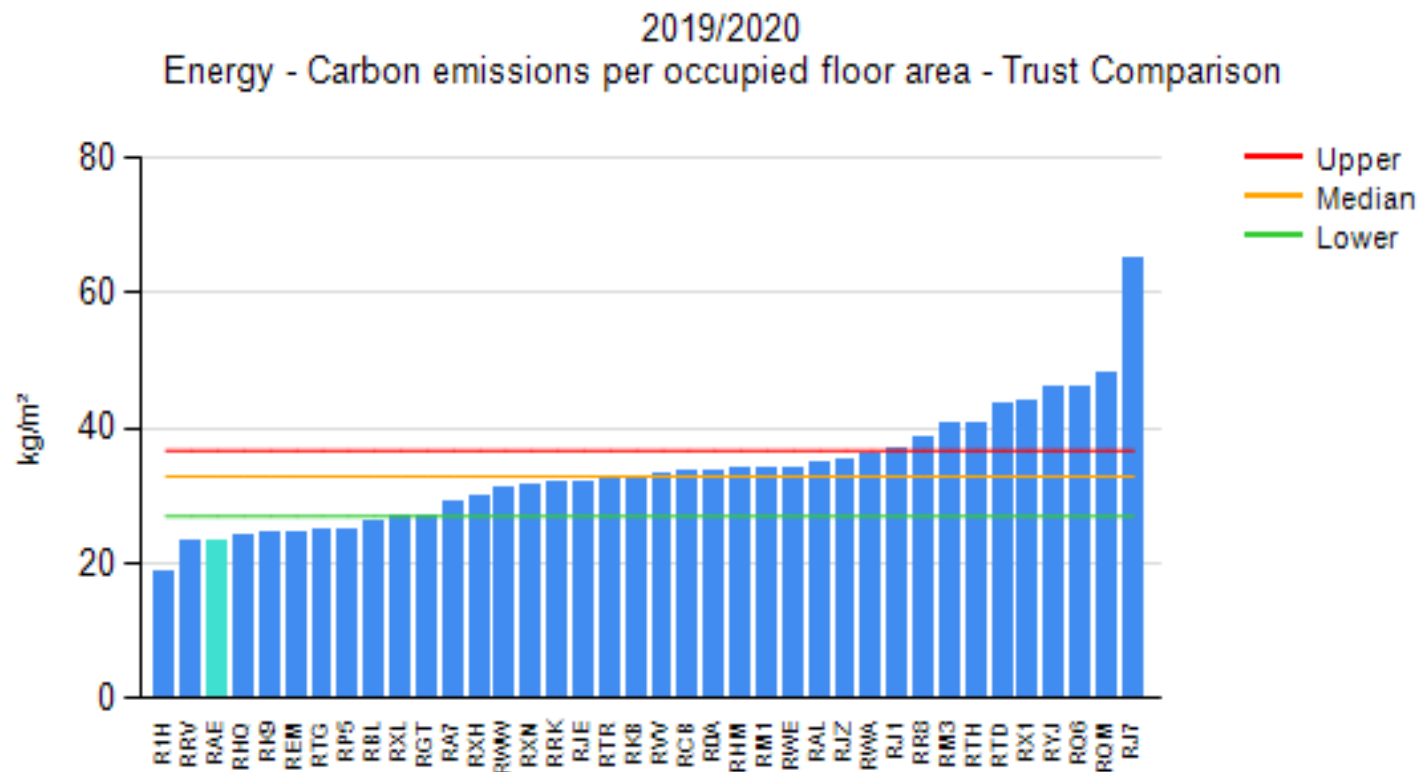
- Green Plan was Board approved in January 2020.
- Officially launched on new Green Plan Trust webpage on World Environment Day (5th June 2020).
- New governance arrangements established in August 2020.
- Sub Groups being set up to support the Green Plan Implementation Group and deliver first year (January 2020 – 31st March 2021) work plans.

Green Plan Highlights

- All major electricity supplies are 100% certified renewable from August 2020 and the remaining periphery properties will move to 100% certified renewable electricity by April 2021.
- The Trust has introduced and embraced the use of video consultations with patients. This initiative has since the launch saved the Trust the equivalent road miles to travel once around the Earth and 10 tonnes of CO₂e emissions.

- Energy – ERIC 2019/20 Carbon Emissions (3rd lowest place)

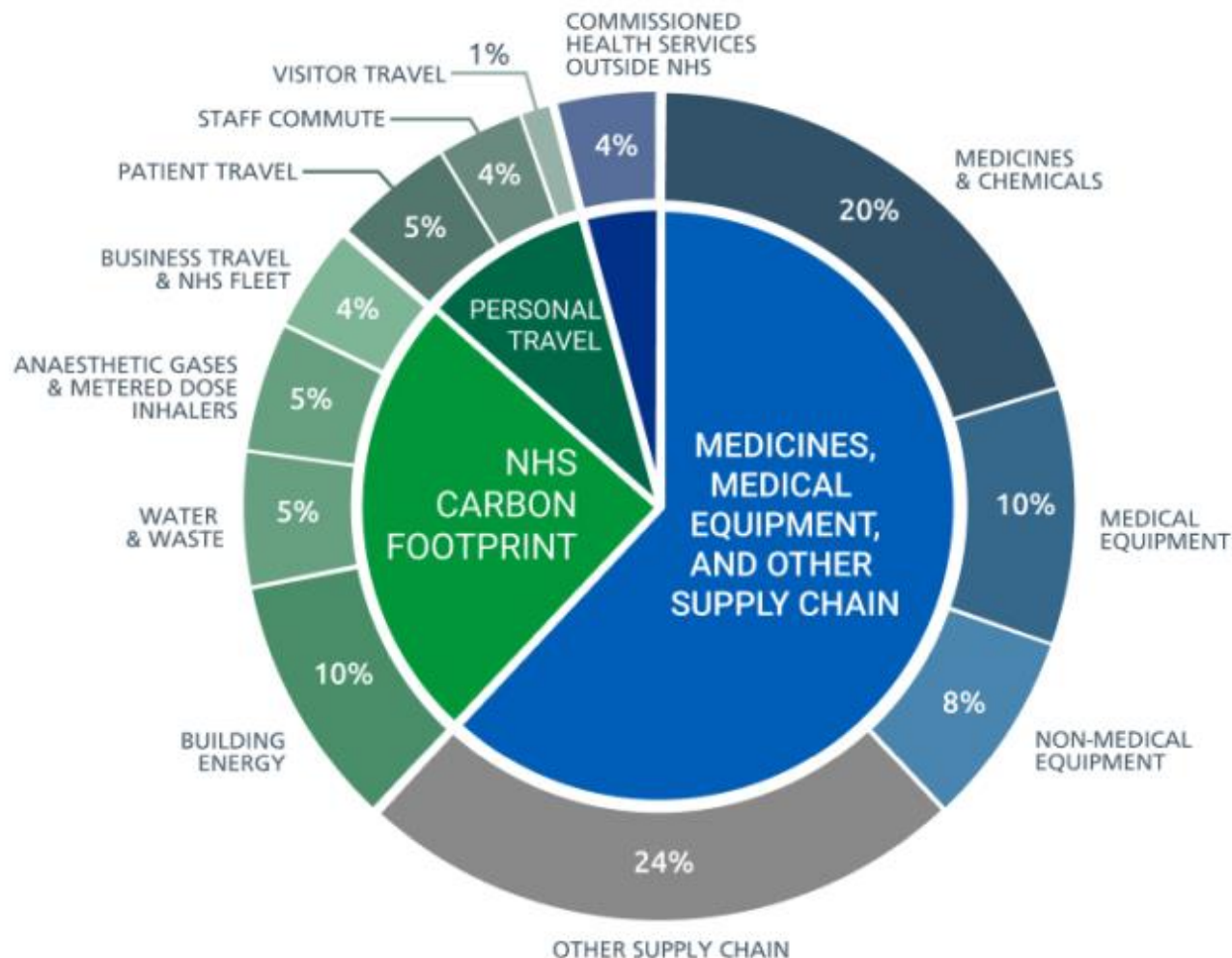

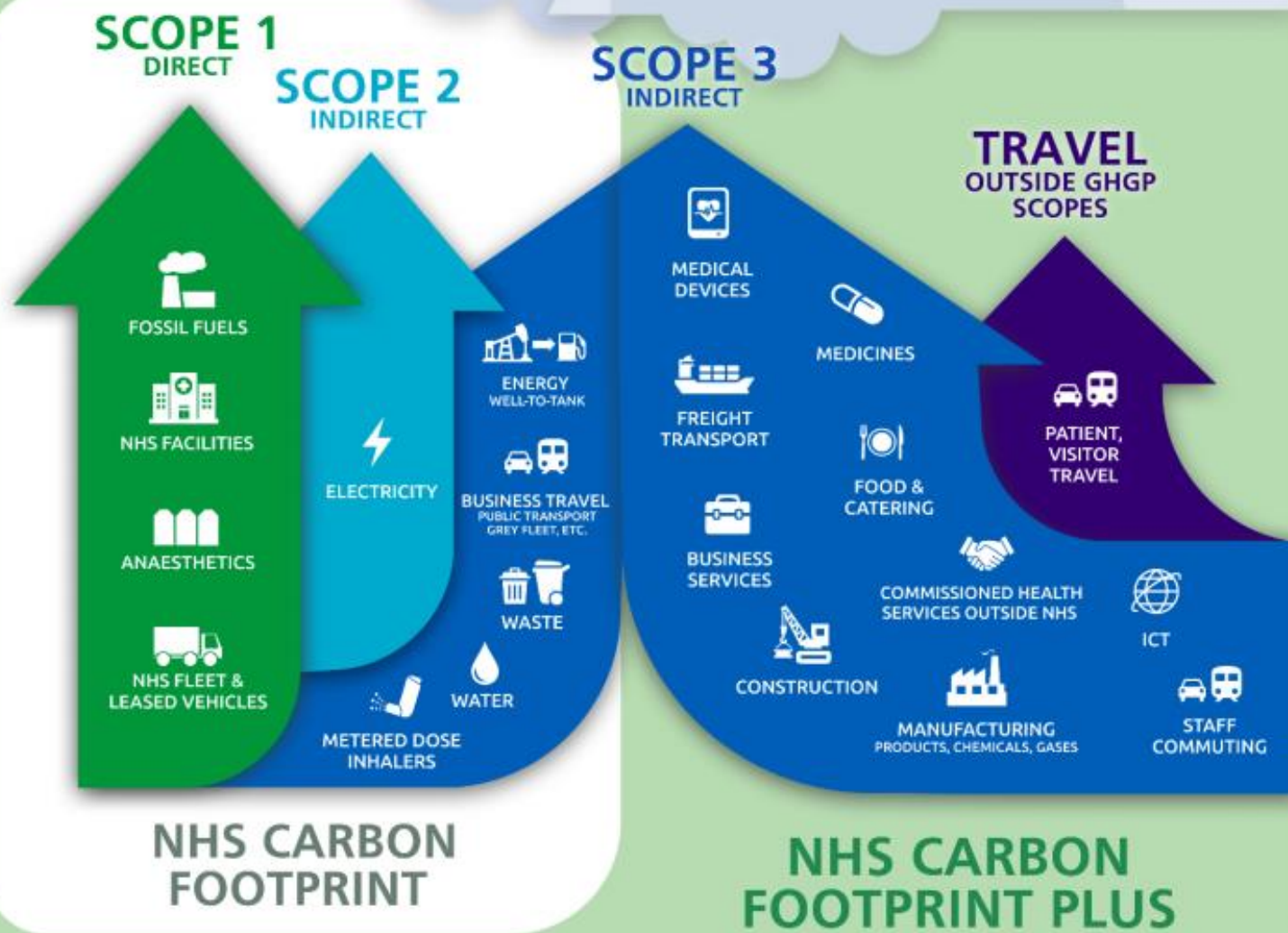
- 'Delivering a Net Zero National Health Service' released on the 1st October 2020.

NHS Carbon Footprint

Bradford Teaching Hospitals
NHS Foundation Trust



All Trust services and operations carbon emissions must be calculated and reduced. The remaining emissions will need offsetting. Therefore this will impact all aspects of the Trust.



Net Zero Target

- for the *NHS Carbon Footprint* (emissions under NHS direct control), net zero by 2040, with an ambition for an interim 80% reduction by 2028-2032, and;
- for the *NHS Carbon Footprint Plus*, (which includes our wider supply chain), net zero by 2045, with an ambition for an interim 80% reduction by 2036-2039.

Net Zero Targets

Other Local and National Targets

- Bradford Council and Leeds City Region;
 - Net zero in Carbon Emissions by 2038 across the whole district or region.
- Climate Change Act 2008;
 - Legal requirement for all organisations in England to be net zero by 2050.

Next Steps

- Further NHSE Guidance is due later in 2021.
- Future Trust decisions on products we procure and services we deliver need to incorporate the carbon emissions impact (both positive or negative) to ensure we achieve Net Zero carbon emissions.
