### Key Options, Issues and Risks

To approve the 2020-21 annual accounts and report for Bradford Hospitals Charity.

### Analysis

The draft unaudited 2020-21 annual accounts and report for Bradford Hospitals Charity was previously presented at the July 21 Charitable Fund Committee. The accounts were subsequently audited in November / December 21.

Since the draft accounts were submitted in July 21, two changes have been made plus a few minor changes.

The Balance Sheet position has changed from £2.346m to £2.390m. The reason for the change was due to:

- £11k outstanding debtor has been added – this was due from the Trust to the Charity and has now been paid across.
- £33k creditors have been reduced – a few creditors were raised based on purchase orders rather than goods being received. This has now been amended.

During the year, income (excluding unrealised and realised investment losses) was £957,001, an increase of £521,077 on the previous year, £435,924. Total expenditure for the year was £841,559, which represents an increase of £320,688 on the previous year, £520,871. This resulted in an excess of income over expenditure of £115,442 which, together with realised and unrealised gains from the investment portfolio totalling £255,498, has led to an overall increase in net assets of £370,940.
