



Using CamAPS FX at School

CamAPS FX is a sophisticated insulin delivery system for people with type 1 diabetes that is very easy to use.

- CamAPS FX is an app that continually adjusts the insulin delivery via an insulin pump based on the glucose sensor data it receives.
 - It has to be connected via Bluetooth to the insulin pump and sensor to work, so the phone with the app needs to stay within 6m of the person.
- People using the system still need to carbohydrate count and give an insulin bolus, via the CamAPS FX app, for any meals or snacks (ideally 10-15 minutes before eating).
