Standard ai	All perinatal deaths eligible to be notified to MBRRACE UK from 6 May 2022 onwards must be notified to MBRRACE-UK within seven working days and the surveillance information where required must be completed within one month of the death.	<p>100% of eligible cases have been reported to MBRRACE within 7 days.</p> <p>1 case missed the 1 month completion deadline by 4 days. (Maternal death). Standard aii	A review using the Perinatal Mortality Review Tool (PMRT) of 95% of all deaths of babies, suitable for review using the PMRT, from 6 May 2022 will have been started within two months of each death. This includes deaths after home births where care was provided by your Trust.	<p>This standard has been achieved (excluding cases assigned to other Trusts)</p> <p>All but 1 case met this standard (97%). This is the maternal death case mentioned above which NHSR are aware of as a mitigating case.</p> <p>3 cases did not meet this standard but these were assigned to another organisation due to being in-utero/ex-utero transfers.</p> <p>81953 - IUT from Chesterfield at 23+4 due to PPROM at 23+2.</p> <p>81757 – Booked at Airedale. Ambulance diverted appropriately to a unit that can provide NICU services to</p>

		<p>extreme premature baby 22+5/40.</p> <p>81508 – Antenatal and intrapartum care at Chesterfield. Postnatal transfer to BTHFT neonatal unit.</p> <p>Technical guidance states – ‘It is recognised that if you need to assign a review to another Trust this may affect the ability to meet some of the deadlines for starting, completing and publishing that review. This will be accounted for in the external validation process’. This has also been confirmed by NHSR in the attached email.</p>
Standard b	At least 50% of all deaths of babies (suitable for review using the PMRT) who were born and died in your Trust, including home births, from 6 May 2022 will have been reviewed using the PMRT, by a multidisciplinary review team. Each review will have been completed to the point that at least a PMRT draft report has been generated by the tool within four months of each death and the report published within six months of each death.	<p>This standard has been achieved.</p> <p>There were 14 eligible cases for part bi and all but 2 (86%) were completed to draft by 4 months of the death. 1 of these was the maternal death case.</p> <p>There were 10 eligible cases for part bii and 100% were completed to a published report by 6 months of the death.</p>
Standard c	For at least 95% of all deaths of babies who died in your Trust from 6 May 2022, the parents will have been told that a review of their baby’s death will take place, and that the parents’ perspectives and any questions and/or concerns they have about their care and that of their baby have been sought. This includes any home births where care was provided by your Trust staff and the baby died either at home or in your Trust. If delays in completing reviews are	<p>This standard has been achieved.</p> <p>There were 39 eligible cases for this standard and all (100%) parents were told that a review of their baby’s death will take place, and their perspectives and questions and/or concerns about their care and that of their baby have been sought.</p>

	<p>anticipated parents should be advised that this is the case and be given a timetable for likely completion.</p> <p>Trusts should ensure that contact with the families continues during any delay and make an early assessment of whether any questions they have can be addressed before a full review has been completed; this is especially important if there are any factors which may have a bearing on a future pregnancy. In the absence of a bereavement lead ensure that someone takes responsibility for maintaining contact and for taking actions as required.</p>
