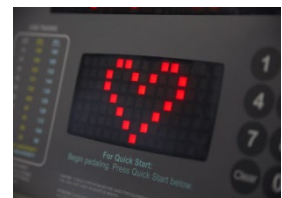
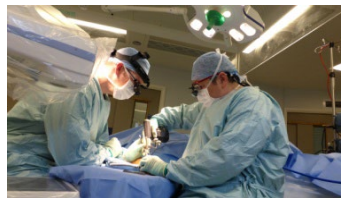

# Learning

- Training compliance has increased – training offered is responsive
- Mental health attendances continue to increase in complexity . CAMHS huddles, Crisis Pathway, need work with partner agencies.
- National review for Star Hobson - learning being disseminated through stand alone sessions
- Weekly good practice newsletter to the Emergency department.
- EPR and it's ability to flag and talk to other systems.
- More efficient and effective ways of working within the team have freed time for visibility and development.



# Improvement

- Audit for Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health standards for Child Protection Medicals met 99/103 standards
- Policy development- Guideline for the Clinical Management of Distressed, agitated and violent patients under the age of 18 is live.
- Increased offers of Safeguarding Supervision within the team and to wider teams.
- Business Case approved for 2<sup>nd</sup> Named Doctor post.
- New training strategy introduced April
- Improved visibility of the team – BONES and ED



# Assurance

- Continued increases in referrals to the team – staff recognising concerns.
- Very small numbers of missed concerns via screening.
- Daily multi-agency and partnership working to continue to support improvements to practice - focus on Thorpe Model & Mental Health.
- Responsive safeguarding training and training figures improvement
- Work plan and Audit strategy for 2023/24 produced.
